Materials Needed: Please bring the following materials to class every day unless I tell you otherwise – pencils, paper, a red pen for correcting and a scientific calculator. If you plan to buy a graphing calculator then a TI-89 is best. (Save the UPC for extra credit!) You may also need a compass, protractor, and colored pencils.

Grading: 90% of your grade will be weighted as follows:

70% Assessments

30% Assignments

10% of your semester grade will be based on your final exam score.

Attendance: It is easier to learn math if you are in class, please be here as often as possible! Make sure you are in your seat and ready to learn before class starts. If you are absent, please show me your excused admit slip at the beginning of the period and make arrangements to correct your homework, get any handouts, or take a test. If you have a pre-arranged absence (field trip, athletic event, doctors appointment, etc.) you must ask for your assignment BEFORE the absence and have it completed upon your return.

Assignments: We will usually take one or two days to complete a set. You will receive a calendar at the beginning of each month, which will assist you in keeping track of your assignments and upcoming tests or quizzes. It is your responsibility to keep your calendar up to date and record any changes on it.

Assessments: Usually our quizzes will cover 4 or 5 sets of material and will be about 4 sets behind. For example after we complete set 68 we will have a quiz on sets 60-64. We should have a quiz approximately every other week and I will try not to schedule them on the first day of the week (unless we miss class unexpectedly).

Behavior: I expect students to behave appropriately at all times. Please be courteous and respectful to everyone in our room. In addition, I expect you to conduct yourself in a manner that is conducive to learning math. You may not use cell phones, headphones, electronic games, or other forms of entertainment in my classroom. Please make sure your friends and family know that it is inappropriate to call or text you during class.

Extra Help: I am usually available to help students before school, after school, during break, and during lunch. Stop by if you need help or talk to me to arrange a time.
