Eatonville High School Code for SAT and ACT registration is 480335. The registration deadline for the next SAT (June 4th) is May 6th. Go to www.collegeboard.com. The registration deadline for the next ACT (June 11th) is May 6th. Go to www.actstudent.org. **Note: Every SAT and ACT has a *Late registration date* for which there is an additional charge.

Reminder Seniors: The Dollars for Scholars application is due on Friday, April 29th. Be sure you have attached a transcript (with SAT/ACT scores on the back) and turn in the application to the EHS Career Center by 3:00pm. You are required to sign when you turn it in; do not just drop it off.

Attention Seniors: Tuesday, May 31st is the last day to turn in make-up credits from outside courses for graduation. If you are not clear on this policy, see your EHS Counselor ASAP.

Attention Running Start Seniors: If you are taking courses needed for EHS graduation, be sure to bring confirmation of passing grades from your Pierce College instructors to your EHS Counselors.

EHS Seniors are scheduled to visit the career center on Monday, May 2nd during CWP classes to retrieve their career and writing portfolios as part of the process for completing their Sr Project Notebooks. **Running Start Seniors are welcome to join a class period on this day as well, or come in after 2:20pm**.
