Eatonville High School Code for SAT and ACT registration is 480335. The registration deadline for the next SAT (May 1st) is March 25th. Register for the *Reasoning Test* if you are planning to take the basic SAT. Go to www.collegeboard.com. The registration deadline for the next ACT (April 10th) is March 5th. Go to www.actstudent.org.
**Note: Every SAT and ACT has a *Late* registration date for which there is an additional charge.
