The presentation component will consist of an 8-12 minute speech before an audience of staff, community members and students. Use an introduction such as: quotation, startling statement/statistic, challenging question, short demonstration, attention-capturing incident or illustration, an immediate issue or challenge or a brief reference to self, topic or occasion).

BODY: What 3-5 main ideas will you include in your presentation?
Support detail with specific examples, including source citations. Explain what you have learned as a result of courses taken at EHS and explain how you will apply that learning later in life. Be sure to refer to your research paper and community experience.

Choose one of the six ways to conclude your speech (summary, recap, anecdote, analogy or simile, restate your thesis, vivid illustration with words, or a call for action from the audience).
